















































































































































PREFACE

I am honored to be asked to write this preface about the author of this monumental history of Cal Beta, Paul Manolis. I first met Paul in the spring of 1951, when he was the pledge master of our pledge class, and I have followed his many contributions to the good of our chapter over a period spanning more than sixty years, probably longer than any other brother.

During these many years Paul served as chapter advisor for ten years and was named by the SAE National as the Outstanding Chapter Advisor in 1981. From 1977 to 1990, he was a board member of the House Corporation and spent several years as its chairman. The Supreme Council of SAE has conferred upon Paul the Merit Key Award for his outstanding services, which include serving on the faculty of the Leadership School. He was founder and president of the Cal Beta 1894 Alumni Association, which raised more than \$100,000 for a chapter endowment. In 2010 he was a member of the first class inducted into the Cal Beta Hall of Fame.

As a professional historian, Paul was the obvious person for this project of writing and compiling a history of the chapter. When the chapter fell into disorder, he gathered up its written records, which included the original minutes of the chapter's founding, and kept them in his home. In 1994 he spoke of the

Accumulating the information for this book required Paul's expenditure of time, effort, thought, and considerable personal expense, including a trip to our national headquarters, where he spent several days researching in the archives at the Levere Memorial Temple.

Two of Paul's sons are SAEs, George (Oregon Beta '88) and Dimitri (Cal Beta '85, deceased), and his brother, Gus, was Cal Beta '47 (deceased). As you can see, Cal Beta and SAE run very deep in the Manolis family.
