<u>Upstairs Hallway Tile Project</u>

As you may be aware, we have invested over \$1 million in renovations and improvements to the SAE Chapter House over the past six years. The next major improvement project is to tile the upstairs hallway with ceramic, Mexican-style tiles. Last summer we tiled the downstairs hallway with similar tiles and they are working out great. The pictures to the right were recently taken of both the upstairs and downstairs hallways, so hopefully this gives you a pretty good idea of what we are describing.

Not only do these ceramic tiles improve the overall look of the house consistent with its architecture, they will save us money in the long term as we will not have to re-carpet the hallway every three to five years. And as you can imagine, they are much easier to clean.

Based on the cost of the downstairs tile work, we estimate the upstairs project will cost approximately \$25,000. We plan to hang an engraved plaque at the top of the front stairs to give recognition to all of you who contribute. 

EA's Report - Fall 2009

This year's Duck Dinner, held on the night before the USC game, was the biggest and best – ever! In case you missed it, over 150 alumni and actives were treated to a fine steak dinner followed by a rousing speech by former Cal Rose Bowl quarterback Joe Kapp. The Cal band also made a special appearance towards the end of the night. Thank you to John Williams and all the alumni volunteers who made it all possible.

The house is full with 41 live-ins and 65 actives. We believe this ranks us in the top five in terms of number of members of all Cal fraternities. We also have the largest pledge class in recent history with 19 pledges, including 4 rugby players, 3 members of the NCAA champion crew team, and 1 from track and field.

Active members include five Cal football players – Mike Tepper, Mike Mohammed, Garry Graffort, Nick Demopolous, and Ryan Wertenberger. We have other varsity athletes on the track & field, volleyball, crew, and rugby teams, including All-American rugby players Colin Hawley and Keegan Engelbrecht.

Current ASUC President, Will Smelko, is an active live-in member, who has worked tirelessly to improve the chapter's standing with the University.

South Seas 2009 was a huge success – the biggest turnout since 2001. The back parking lot was transformed into a sand-filled South Seas beach and pool. Three bands performed, including one made up entirely of active members.

Our annual philanthropy volleyball tournament at South Seas raised \$1,000 for Camp Kesem, a camp for children whose parents have been diagnosed with cancer.
